3) How do you personally feel about the words of Jesus in verse 34? In verse 43?

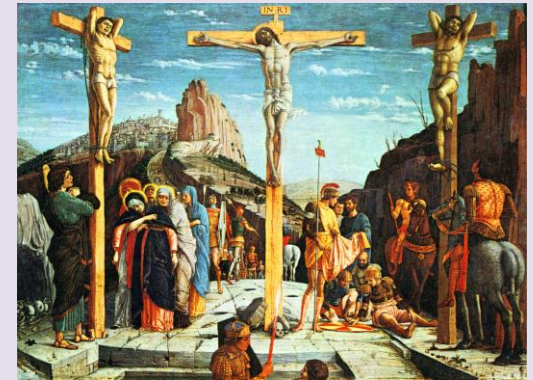

(v. 26) *Simon of Cyrene*

See Mark 15:2-22 – the father of Alexander and Rufus (whoever they were)

(v. 28) *do not weep for Me*

(v. 29-30) *... the time will come ...*

See Hosea 10:1-2, 8

(v. 31) *... the green tree ... the dry tree*

Notes on verses 32-38:

THE PLACE CALLED THE SKULL

(v. 33) *The place called the Skull*

Calvary = Latin

Golgotha = Aramaic

(v. 34) *Father, forgive them*

(v. 35, 37) *If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself*

Notes on verses 39-43:

JESUS AND THE CRIMINALS

(v.39) *Save yourself and us!*

(v. 40) *the other criminal*

(v. 42) *when you come into your kingdom*

(v. 43) *Today you will be with Me*
